### Parish Transition Update

This past week members of our parish staff and other parish organizational leaders met to discuss plans for the upcoming retirement of Father Seamus. We all agreed that a priority for our parish during this time is to **clearly and effectively communicate to our parishioners what is happening**. As with any change, there are some facts we know for certain, and others we won't know for awhile. Here's what we know for now.

Father Seamus' request to retire was approved by Archbishop Sartain, effective June 30, 2015.

He will be on his annual vacation from April 27 - till June 4.

It is likely his last day at St. Pats will be June 30.

Plans have begun for a farewell party on Saturday, June 20.

There is no word yet from the Archdiocese on his replacement. There is an archdiocesan meeting the week of April 27-30 to discuss priest assignments diocesan wide.

We hope to be notified of Father's replacement sometime during the week of May 10-15.

We will publicly announce his replacement soon after we are notified by the archdiocese.

On Friday, April 24, our parish staff will meet with Leigh Stringfellow, from the Vicar of Clergy Office, to discuss transition issues we need to prepare for.

**We also want to hear from you.** We realize change can be hard, especially with a pastor who has been with us for so long. If have questions, concerns, or suggestions to help the parish through this transition period, please bring them to the attention of our Parish Staff who have the most reliable and up to date information.

In the meantime, trust patiently that the Holy Spirit is our advocate in this transition; keep praying for Father Seamus and for our parish and for each other.
