Confused about what session to register your child?

- Level I children are ages 3 or 4 to begin. They are in this level I for 3 years. Children must be toilet trained.
- Level II is for children who have been in the level I atrium for 3 years. Generally the children are 6-9 years of age at this level.
- Level III is for children who have completed level I and II. Generally children are ages 9-12+ at this level.

Also:

Children are expected to commit to the whole two hour atrium session for the entire year. Exceptions to this policy will be taken on a case-by-case basis. Please set up an appointment with Kim if there is a situation you would like to discuss before enrolling your child, or if you would like to discuss payment. Also, please contact Kim if the fee presents a financial hardship.
