Over the years we built our church, built a school, renovated the church, moved the school from the parish into the old Aquinas Academy, and more. We have weathered seasons of change and challenges with grace, and never more so than the past three years when Archbishop Sartain asked us to operate without a resident pastor.

Under this new leadership model, parishioners discerned and discovered our Parish Mission, Values & Priorities. In turn, these shared principles guided key decisions we have made on behalf of the parish. Most notably, we have a robust Youth Group inspiring our young Catholics to know and love Jesus. We have a flourishing Stephen Ministry providing pastoral care to our community, and an energized ALPHA program, inviting participants to discover Jesus as the answer to life's tough questions. As we've seen our efforts in pastoral care, evangelization, and youth grow, we've also witnessed new leadership take hold in our 40+ ministry groups and our Councils and Commissions. During a time when many parishes are experiencing lags in leadership and volunteerism, St. Patrick is thriving with the support of talented parishioners dedicating their time and resources. Similarly, while many churches have experienced a decline in attendance and contributions, we have experienced three years of growth— reversing a 10-year period of declines.

The 2018 Pastoral Council extends our gratitude to each of you. The creative tools and resources your gifts provide help to spread the word of God and have ignited a fire in our parish community. It is our hope that you will be inspired by this Parish Annual Report to see the good your stewardship provides and, if called, to do even more with your time, talent and treasure. Together we invite you to remember our past, celebrate our present and embrace the future.



# CELEBRATING THE PRESENT | 6 Stewardship of Treasure

As a result of your continued commitment and generosity in 2018, we were able to invest \$1.3 million into various ministries, programs and pastoral staff that allowed us to continue to fulfill our Parish Mission.

To help explain what we "do" as a parish, we categorized the various ministries, services and programs into five functional areas:


- Liturgy and Worship

Four major sources of revenue allow us to do our mission work:

- Sacrificial Giving
- Rental Income
- Unprojected Revenue
- All Other Revenue


Sacrificial Giving is our largest source of revenue (77%); we are blessed by the generosity of our parishioners. Nearly half (551) of our 1,139 households pledged their Time, Talent and Treasure to serve our community. A total of 811 parishioners made financial contributions in 2018.

Salaries and Administrative & Operating Expenses are pro-rated across the five areas




Saint Patrick Catholic School is, first and foremost, a ministry of our Parish and grounded in the Catholic faith, as we seek to bring our children to the ever-present love of Jesus Christ. We began the 2017-2018 school year with 355 bright and eager students grades Pre-K thru 8. In June, 90% of our 8th graders matriculated to Bellarmine Prep to continue their Catholic education. With the help of our caring and talented faculty, we challenged ourselves to use data to inform instruction, and build a positive school culture where older students mentor younger students.

Central to our vision of forming young people of competence and conscience was encouraging students and their families to act for justice. We integrated service and charity work in all of our classes throughout the year, as we believe it is through service that our students build lifelong empathy and compassion for those in need. In 2018, our middle school students devoted over 1,200 service hours and school families performed over 7,900 hours of service to our school, parish, and the greater Tacoma area!

In alignment with our Parish Mission, Values & Priorities, Saint Patrick Catholic School continues to welcome all who seek a Catholic education. Students continue to grow in their faith and share the Good News of Christ with the blessings of weekly liturgy, access to the sacraments, and the support of parishioners and parish ministries throughout the year.

We are grateful for our history with the Dominican Sisters and we pray in thanksgiving for our Parish family. No matter your title—student, alumni, administrator, faculty or staff— at St. Pats School, every day is a great day to be a Shamrock!

### YOUTH MINISTRY

For several years, the Youth Ministry at Saint Patrick Catholic Church had only a handful of participants. Youth leaders were splitting a part-time position between Youth Ministry and preparing teens for the Sacrament of Confirmation. In 2017 the Pastoral Council completed a long-range planning process and adopted our new Parish Mission, Values & Priorities. The newly defined priorities of *Reaching Out to Young People* and *Keeping our Community Vibrant*, inspired parish leadership to allocate resources to hire a full-time Youth Minister, Allison Verhofstadt.

This investment in staffing allowed our youth ministry to grow exponentially. Today, youth are forming relationships across parish boundaries and outside of their school environment. They are forging friendships in their shared faith and joyfully engaging in an environment where virtue is celebrated and prayer is encouraged.

Youth Nights are exciting at St. Pats youth gather for weekly formation, service projects, fellowship, friendship and fun. Your gifts of time, talent and treasure to Saint Patrick Catholic Church have allowed this ministry to come alive and we are grateful!
