Feedback Sessions Review

1. Feedback sessions were designed to address the questions “Who are we?” and “What are our gifts?”

3. Impressions:
 - Saint John Vianney had a good turnout at their session. There was a good spread of ages. Participants were positive about their experience as parishioners of SJV and the role the community has had in their spiritual growth. Concerns about input and the future in respect to clergy presence on the island and Mass times were raised.
 - Saint Patrick had low attendance at both sessions. The age range was 60 and up. Participants were positive about their experience as parishioners of Saint Pats and the role the community has had in their spiritual growth.
 - Holy Cross sessions were well attended. Participants were positive about their experience as parishioners at Holy Cross. Concerns were raised about the future of the parish with fears that the parish would be closed as a result of Partners. They desire more activities and ministries in the parish.

Father Lazzeroni Meeting

There were about 80 people from around the diocese in attendance. Attendees were able to ask questions and provide feedback.

Next Steps:
