Uniform and Dress Code Guidelines

Sweaters	Dark green	Uniform Store only. Long sleeve, V-neck pullover or cardigan All sweaters must be worn with collared shirts beneath
Uniform Sweatshirts	Dark green	Long sleeves, crew neck*, Uniform Store only All sweatshirts must be worn with collared shirts beneath *Middle School may wear dark green zippered sweatshirts with cadet collars.
Vests	Dark green	V-neck knit or fleece with logo, Uniform Store only All vests must be worn with collared shirts beneath
Shirts	Solid white or dark green	Must have collars (turtlenecks allowed) May have logo if purchased through Uniform Store Tucked in
Pants	Solid navy blue	Chino or cord, uniform-style dress slacks, worn at waist Hem at top of shoe
Shorts	Solid navy blue	Walking style, top of knee length, fitted, worn at waist May be worn all year
Jumpers	Kirk plaid	Pre-K-5 girls, Uniform Store only Top of knee length
Skirts	Kirk plaid	Grade 6-8 girls, Uniform Store only Worn at waist, no rolling, top of knee length
Skorts	Kirk plaid	Pre-K-8 girls, Uniform Store only
Undershirts	Solid white	Tucked in, not visible
Belts	Navy, brown, or black--solid	
Shoes	Matching	No platforms, heels <1", non-skid, sturdy, fully-enclosed

		(Must have tennis shoes for PE days)
Socks	Matching	Socks must match
Leggings	Solid black, white, navy, or dark green	For girls, under uniform skirts only, must wear socks
Outerwear		No depiction of violence, gangs, rocks groups, tobacco, alcohol, etc., allowed
Scout Uniforms		Acceptable on meeting or event days
Spirit Wear		Fridays or previously scheduled days only. Must be purchased through Spirit Wear Store .

Free Dress Days	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Observe modesty • No hoods or hats, or head coverings worn in buildings • No inappropriate images or language on clothing • No undersized, oversized, or unkempt clothing (e.g., no jeans with holes) • No tank tops (unless worn as undergarments) • Girls in grades 6-8 may wear minimal makeup • No bare midriffs (tops should be long enough to tuck into bottoms) • Undergarments should not be visible • Skirts, dresses, and shorts must be no shorter than fingertips when arms are at sides • No baggy sweatpants • Closed-toed shoes only • Non-athletic leggings may be worn, but tops must come to the hip

Makeup	Jewelry
No makeup for grades PreK-5 6 th and 7 th grade girls may wear light makeup on Free Dress Days only 8 th grade girls may wear light makeup No nail polish may be worn to school No fake nails, clear coating, or tips allowed	Post earrings (no larger than a dime) allowed No dangling earrings A wristwatch (non-distracting) is acceptable No bracelets*, rings or anklets allowed Only religious pins or necklaces* allowed Only ear piercings *Medic alert bracelets or necklaces are acceptable

Uniform and Dress Code Non-Compliance Process

1st Offense	Verbal warning
2nd Offense	Verbal warning to student. Written warning via Incident Report
3rd Offense	Verbal warning to student. Written warning via Incident Report Student forfeits next Free Dress Day
4th Offense	Verbal warning to student. Written warning via Incident Report Student forfeits next Free Dress Day In-house suspension--Parent contacted to bring a change of clothes or take student home to achieve compliance
